## Part 1 Strategic litigation in the field of housing rights

## 1. Disputes to solve individual cases

- ✓ **Litigation of opportunity**: a case with a specific issue/ an interesting point of law
- ✓ Recurring problem : the right to housing cannot be applied because of a political practice
- **✓** Purpose:
  - Find a legal solution to a housing issue
  - Change the political practices

**Example:** ECHR, Tchokontio Happi vs. France, April 9th 2015

## Part 1 Strategic litigation in the field of housing rights

### 2. Disputes to change the law

✓ **Identify laws that are not implemented** or do not comply with European obligations in terms of human rights

#### ✓ Purpose:

- National law should comply with European law
- French State should respect European law

**Example :** ECHR Winterstein vs France, October 10th, 2013, 27013/07

# Part 2 Political strategy based on European law and networking

## 1. Networking and mobilization of actors

- ✓ Networking aims at building strategic litigation
- ✓ Mobilization and awareness-raising
- ✓ Trainings, conferences and production of tools

### **Examples:**

- Defense of the rights of people living in slum
- Right to accommodation

# Part 2 Political strategy based on European law and networking

#### 2. Political actions

- **✓** Strategic litigation and bringing cases before European bodies
- ✓ European courts ans bodies' decisions/opinions may be used to put pressure on public authorities, for change in public policies

**Examples** for improving the implementation of the right to housing in France

- FEANTSA collective complaint against France, November 2006
- Complaint before the European Commission, November 2016
- Third party intervention, EHCR, September 2015

- ✓ Advocacy as a link between these two levels, networking and political action, in conjunction with litigation
- ✓ Aim: taking part in legislative and regulation's evolutions
